The ChiArts academic curriculum offers **College Prep (CP)**, **Honors (H)** & **Advanced Placement (AP)** courses.

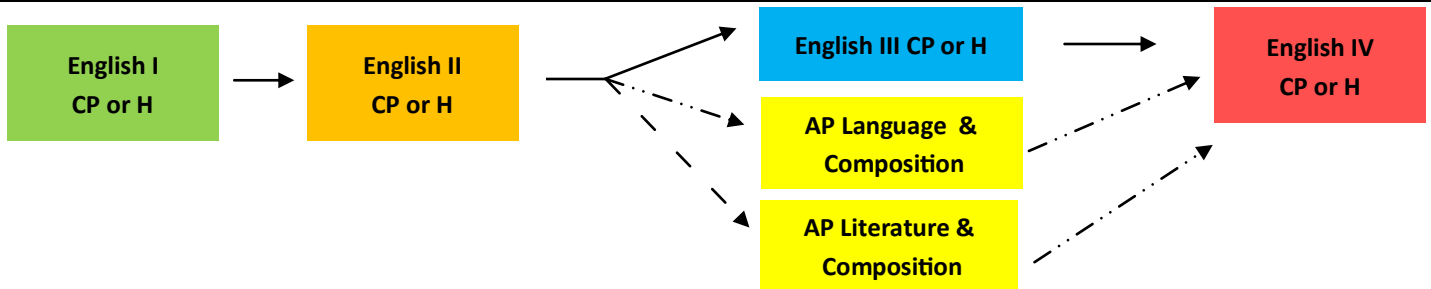
Honors Course Eligibility: 75% (C) or better in the previous semester course in that subject area. For science course eligibility, please see the science section for additional requirements.

AP Course Eligibility: 80% (B-) or better in the previous semester course in that subject area.

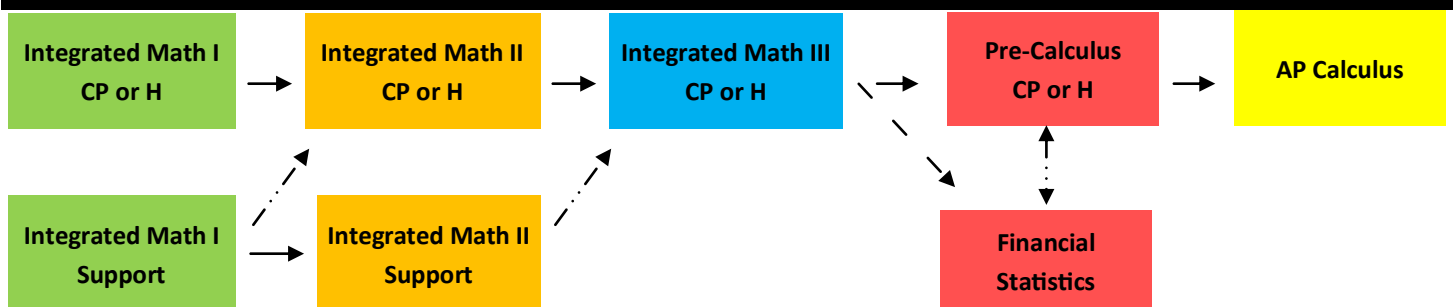
Students who earn a D or F in an honors course may not be recommended for honors in that subject area the next school year.

All courses are subject to change based on enrollment (minimum enrollment thresholds required) and staffing availability.

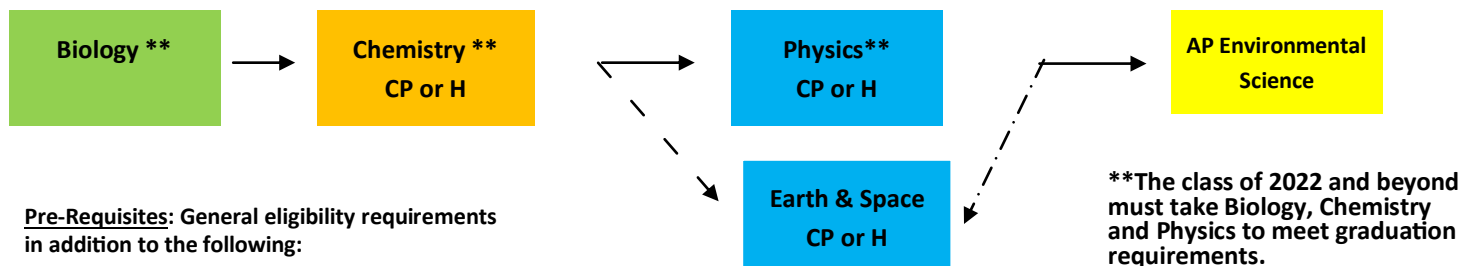

Conservatory Courses —All 4 Years. At least 1 conservatory class per year is credit bearing, and counts in the GPA. All Conservatory classes receive grades. AP Classes are available in Music Theory, Art History, Drawing & Painting, Digital Photography, Sculpture, and Visual Communications, and are limited by conservatory.
