511pm- Meeting begins. Attendance and introductions are completed. 17 people in attendance

513pm-Overview includes discussion about the PEC committee decisions and findings helping to drive the allocations of funds for the school in the coming year, looking to enrich the school for next school year, and wanting more teacher involvement so that we are getting well rounded perspectives.

Focus of the December's meeting will be on next steps and any movement/action that has already taken place towards the accomplishment of the goals of each sub-auxiliary team.

The Conservatory department inquired about and expressed interest in Peer Observations.

Grade level meetings are a good resource for mentorship. Survey is ready for teachers to sign up for mentorship and onboarding volunteers.
